

BASL AWARDS (Clinical case, BASL research grant, BASL basic research grants supported by gilead, BASL best clinical and basic paper)

1. BASL Case Presentation Award

- **objective:** to award the best clinical case presentation during the BASL wintermeeting 4th December 2020
- **amount:** 250€
- **application deadline:** October 1st 2020, via the BASL secretary (sergio.negrindastis@gmail.com)
- **Document to be submitted to the BASL secretary :** an interesting case history, diagnostic process, challenging treatment summarized in max. 1 page, style Times New Roman or Arial, size 12, single spaced) with a challenging title and (co)-author list
- **Conditions:**
 1. For the first author who presents her/his case her/himself
 2. No age restriction
 3. Registered member of the BASL at the moment of presentation

2. BASL research grant

- **Objective:** to support 2 original research projects each year in the field of Hepatology (basic or clinical)
- **Amount:** 2.500€ each
- **Application deadline:** Oktober 1st 2020, via the BASL secretary (Sergio.negrindastis@gmail.com)
- **Conditions:**
 1. The work must be performed at a Belgian institution (hospital or university)
 2. The research proposal must be written in English
 3. The applicant should be holder of an university degree in medicine or in biomedical sciences
 4. The applicant must not be older than 45 years when applying for the grant
 5. The applicant must be registered member of the BASL at application
 6. The grant money is divided into two parts of € 1.250 each, the second part being awarded only under the conditions mentioned in point 7.
 7. The grant holder commits himself to present the results of his work at the BASL Winter Meeting within 1 year after having received the first part of the grant money. Passing this delay or refusing to present the results of the work will automatically suspend the payment of the second part of the grant money.
 8. The grants will be awarded during the annual BASL Winter Meeting by the President of the BASL. The presence of the grant winners at the BASL Winter Meeting is required to receive the grant. The non-compliance with this condition will result in the loss of the grant.

- **Documents to be submitted:**
 - summary of the applicant's (or his research team's) previous work and publications in relationship to the research proposal (max. 1 page, style Times New Roman or Arial, size 12, single spaced)
 - an out-line of the research proposal (max. 2 pages, style Times New Roman or Arial, size 12, single spaced)
 - the applicant's CV
 - a complete list of the applicant's publications
 - These documents should be sent to the current BASL secretary by e-mail (Sergio.negrindastis@gmail.com)

3. BASL basic research AWARDS supported by Gilead

This year, the BASL steering committee is proud to announce a call for BASL basic research grants 2020. There will be **several grants of 20000 Euro**, to stimulate research liver diseases in Belgium

Projects should be submitted to the secretary of BASL (Sergio.negrindastis@gmail.com) before October 1st, 2020.

The winner will be selected by external reviewers. The grants will be officially awarded during the BASL winter meeting on December 4th in Mons.

Instructions for submission:

- **Several grants will be given to basic and/or translational research projects related to liver diseases (no specific topic !)**
- **One of the several grants is given to research related to hepatitis B (basic and/or translational research)**
- **Interventional drug related trials are NOT allowed**
- The projects must be performed in Belgium.
- The applicants should be a BASL member / and must work in a Belgian institution.
- The projects should be written in English. Use Arial 12 font with single line spacing. Maximum 4 pages A4 format.
- The project should be structured as follows:
 - Aim of the study
 - Description of the methods
 - Budget plan (NO salary allowed!) (20000 Euro)
 - Working packages. The project will have to be completed over a 24-month period
- Results of the project will be presented at the BASL wintermeeting of 2022.

4. BASL Awards for best clinical and basic publication of 2019

- **Objective:** to award the best clinical and basic publication in the field of Hepatology during the preceeding year, i.e. 2019.
- **Amount:** 1250€ each
- **Application deadline:** October 1th 2020, via the BASL secretary (Sergio.negrindastis@gmail.com)
- **Document to be submitted to the BASL secretary :** PDF-file of the full paper
- **Conditions:**
 1. For the first author
 2. The author should be registered member of the BASL at submission
 3. Papers published the year before the year of the BASL Winter meeting, i.e. 2018
 4. The awards are given at the BASL Winter Meeting 2020 and are offered to the prize winners only if they are present (not a representative)
